**\*Attention\***

As part of our annual wellness exam/sick visit exam, we are now offering a new, more accurate fecal analysis to test for intestinal parasites. We feel this test, zinc sulfate (ZnSO<sub>4</sub>) centrifugation, will give you (our client) the most assurance in your pet's health and in the safety of you and your family. Some parasites can be passed from pets to people.

\_\_\_\_\_ Yes – I would like to have the ZnSO<sub>4</sub> centrifugation fecal test performed. I also understand there is an additional charge of \$14.30 over the exam fee.

\*If you decline the ZnSO<sub>4</sub> centrifugation fecal test, we will still perform the standard fecal floatation, which is included in the exam fee. This is an appropriate fecal test but not the most accurate.

**\*Attention Owners of Feline Patients\***

If your feline pet comes in contact with the outdoor environment at any time or this is the first visit for your feline pet, we recommend an annual Feline Leukemia Virus (FELV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) test. These two viruses are the most common infectious diseases that cats can contract and carry, sometimes without clinical signs.
